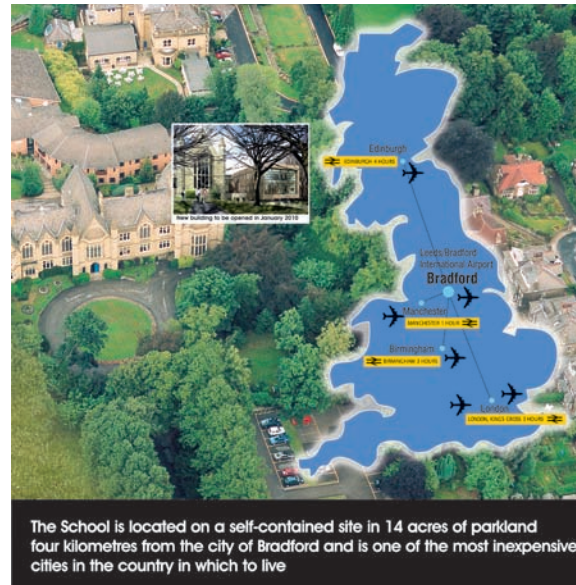

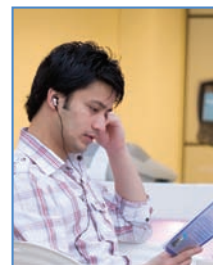
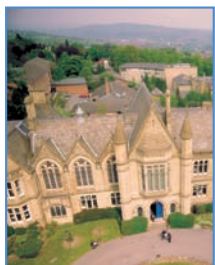

Follow our new fast-track to a Master's degree

As a highly motivated student with good A-level grades, you could be among the first in Britain to benefit from our pioneering "fast track" to a Master's degree with enhanced professional experience. If you already have, or this summer gain, 300 UCAS points at A-level, you can join our new BSc (Hons) in Integrated Management Practice starting in September 2010.

More than just a BSc

This unique course builds on the solid foundations of our current four-year BSc (Hons) degree, which includes a year gaining professional experience. This course is different from others. Not only will you graduate with an honours degree which gives you experience of mentoring others and undertaking live project work, you'll also be well on the way to achieving a MSc in Management - something we don't think you'll find anywhere else in the UK.

What you Study

Year 1
Business Economics Business Law Introduction to Accounting and Finance Foundations of Marketing Foundations of Production and Operations Management Quantitative Methods in Information Management Organisational Information Systems Organisational Behaviour and the Sociology of Work + 2 optional modules
Year 2
Managing Consultative Research Peer Assisted Learning + 10 optional modules
Year 3
You experience 10 months of professional experience in business. During this time, you complete a consultancy project or practical assignment, coached by one of our teaching staff and a mentor at work, which is assessed and counts towards your BSc (Hons) degree
Year 4
Six modules at undergraduate level, including Professional Coaching and Mentoring Skills + Six modules at postgraduate Master's level

Going on to achieve The Bradford MSc

When you have successfully completed your fourth year, you will have gained one third of the credits you need to achieve an MSc in Management. The remaining proportion of your MSc is earned by undertaking a further six postgraduate master's level modules and completing a research dissertation. You have complete flexibility in how you achieve this - you can choose to study by distance-learning whilst in full-time employment, or you may prefer to return to full-time study, the choice is yours!
