

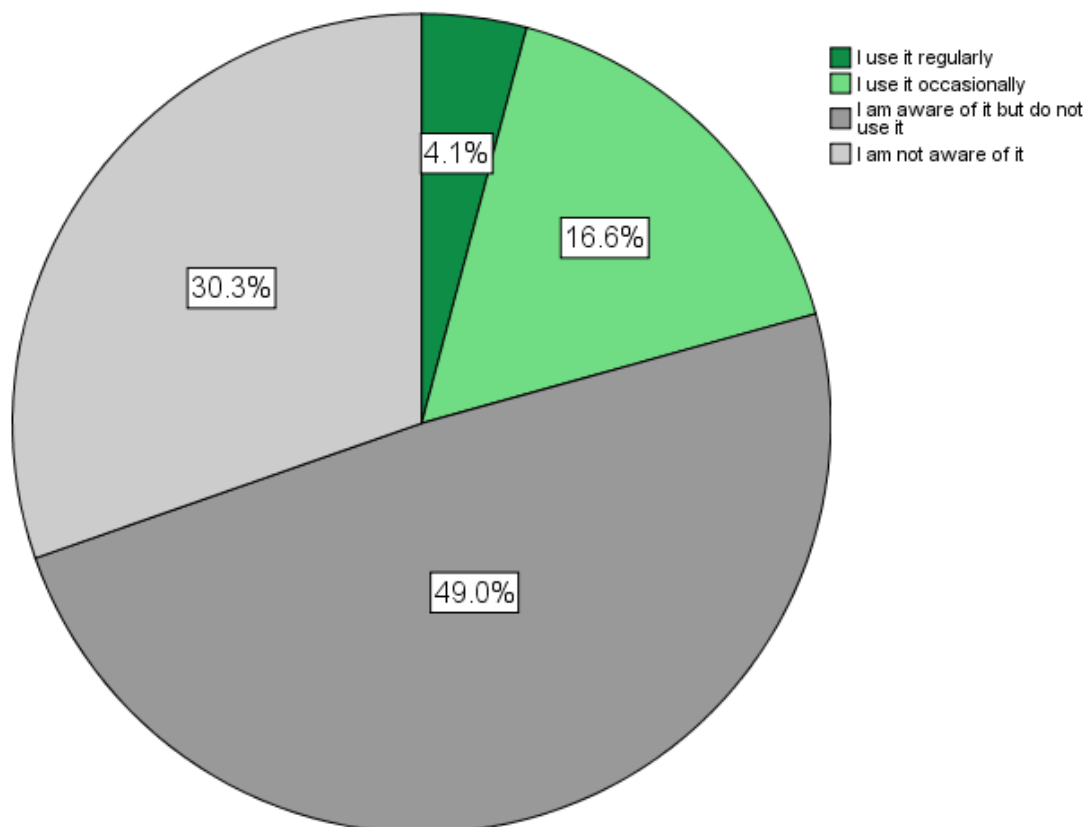
Staff Use of Technology in Teaching And Learning (SUTTL) Survey: Feedback about Computer Assisted Assessment

Introduction

A survey was given to University of Bradford teaching, admin and support staff in April May 2008. This looked at how they used technology in teaching and learning. This report, drawn up with specific reference to the e-learning Pathfinder project, just looks at the parts of the survey that relate to Computer Assisted Assessment.

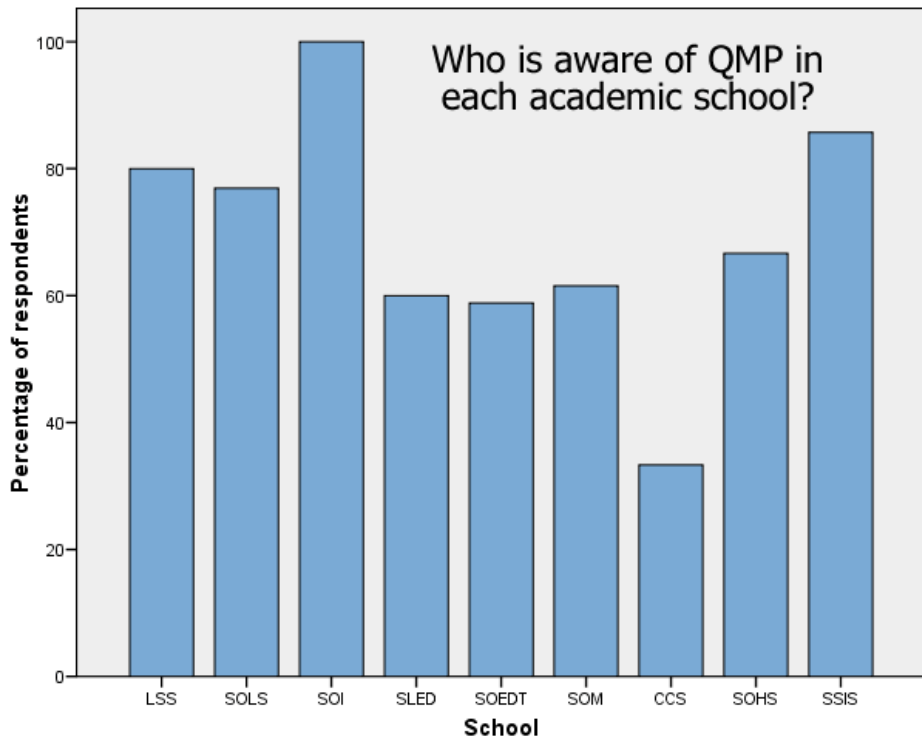
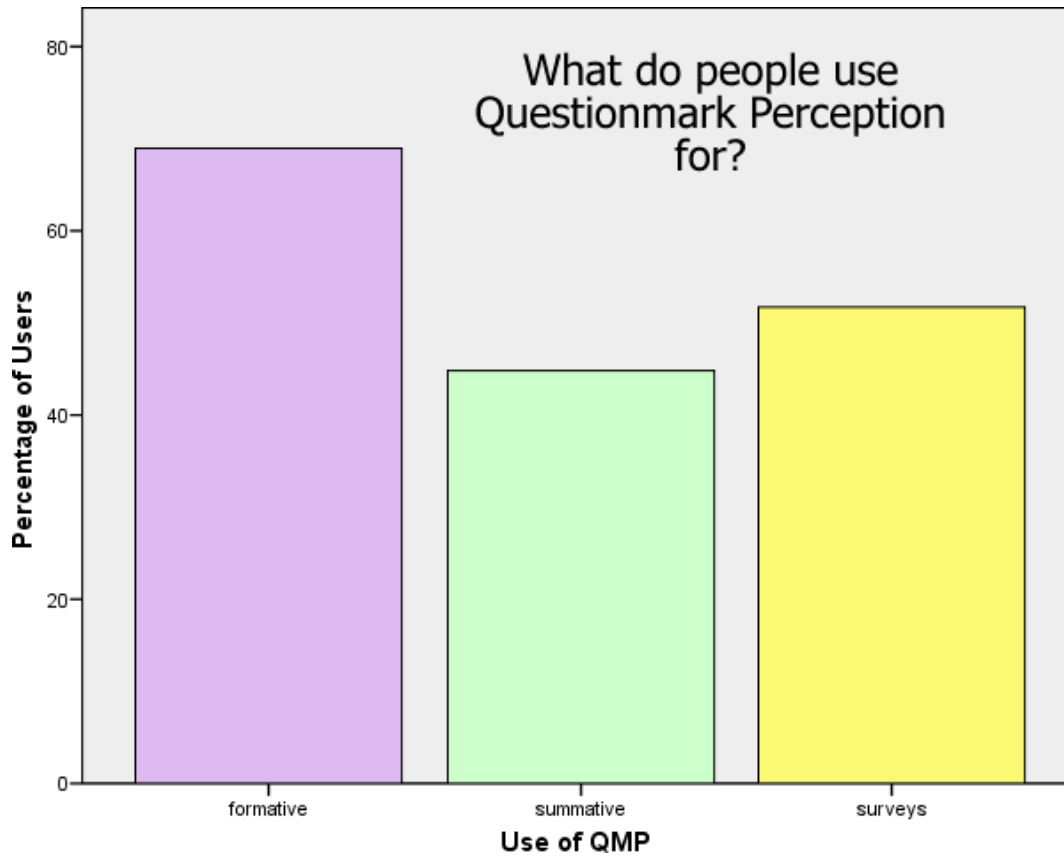
Awareness and Use of Questionmark Perception

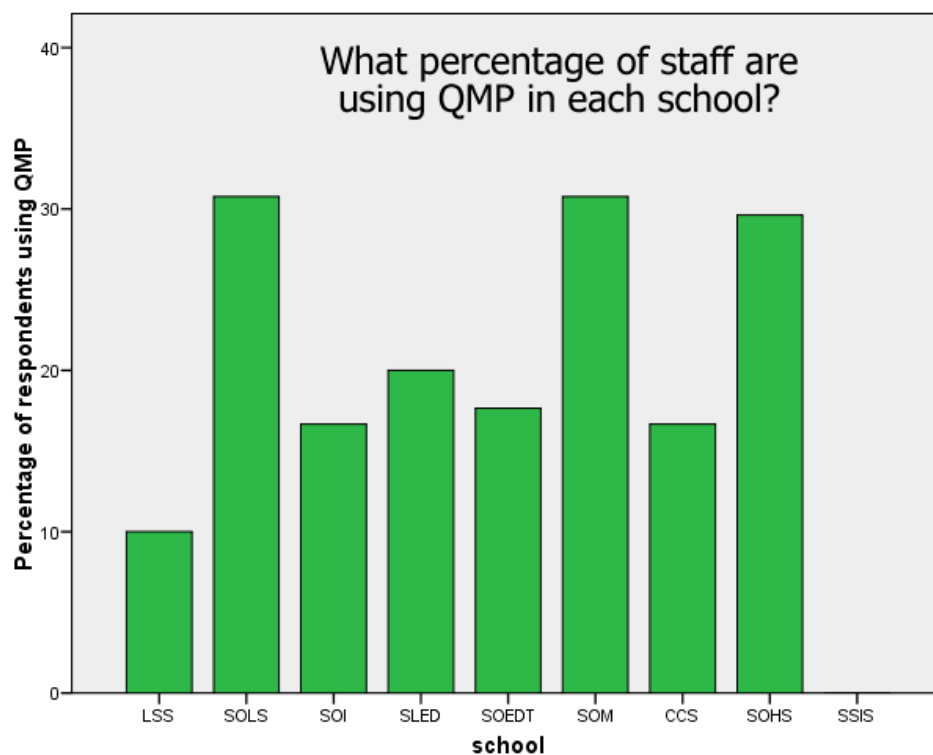
How many people are aware of QMP and how many are using it?



About seventy per cent of the respondents are at least aware of QMP, and about 20 per cent of them are using QMP to some extent. When asked what they use QMP for, more than two thirds (69%) of the users indicated that they used it for formative assessment,

fewer than half (45%) said summative assessment, and about half (52% said) surveys. Many users (48%) are using QMP for more than one use.
