Development Timetable

Site is now fully established with site hoardings completed and access and egress operational. Good progress has been achieved in the demolition with completion of upper floors. Reduce level dig has completed and now we are pouring mass fill foundations for spine walls to commence.

Programme for the next month

Complete all foundations and commence shuttering of basement walls.

Complete all internal demolition

Commence removal of link Structures.

Erect façade scaffolds ready for survey works on existing structures.

ISG are refurbishing the existing Horton A building over four floors and constructing a new extension, which sits between the existing Chesham and Horton D Buildings. This is to be seen as the gateway to the campus for all students, staff and visitors arriving each day. The new facilities are to be state of the art teaching rooms with clinical skill rooms, movement laboratory and digital imagery suite (PACS) being the focal points of the development for students.

With the site being established around the existing Peace garden, ISG have removed a number of plants with the assistance of the university and re-planted these at All Saints School for the children to enjoy and care for. This was seen as a good will gesture towards the people who worked tirelessly to get the gardens created and maintain good community links with local schools.
