

Guidelines on the conferment of honorary degrees on honorary members of staff

The University would not wish to exclude from consideration the conferment of an honorary degree upon a serving honorary member of staff. Such an award would be approved only on an exceptional basis and in those circumstances where the individual concerned had made a significant contribution to a field of academic interest to the University.

Length of service may be taken into account where the recipient has been closely associated with the work of the University over a substantial period of time. This in itself will not, however, constitute a determining factor when considering the award of an honorary degree to an honorary member of staff.
